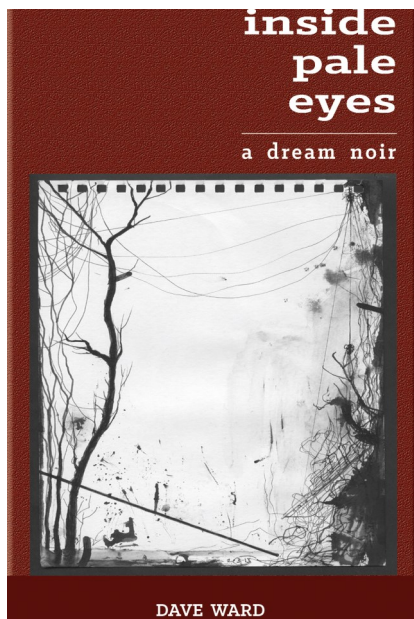

INSIDE PALE EYES

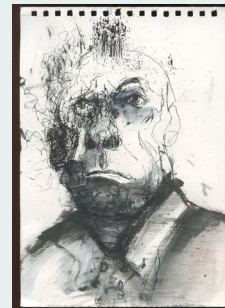

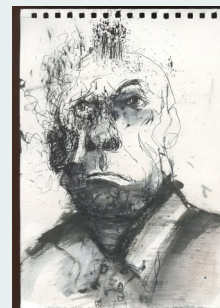
